

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

Howard Community College

and

Dickinson College

Howard Community College and Dickinson College recognize the need and importance of facilitating the transfer of students from HCC to Dickinson College as these students pursue their educational goals. To enhance this transition, a formal articulation agreement between Howard Community College and Dickinson College is being established. It is based on a thorough review of the General Education Core Curriculum at Howard Community College and Dickinson College in parallel programs.


ACADEMICS

- A. A Howard Community College student who completes the requirements for an Associate of Arts Degree with a minimum of a 3.0 average:
1. will have all articulated credits applied to the major, and may complete a Bachelor of Arts degree at Dickinson College within two years (four semesters).
 2. will receive full junior status with the completion of a minimum of 57 credit hours earned at HCC.
 3. will accept the transfer student's G.P.A. as calculated by Howard Community College.
 4. will accept our developmental course sequence as meeting the entry-level requirements for one hundred level courses at Dickinson College.
- B. Appointed institutional representatives at HCC and Dickinson College will insure that appropriate personnel in their respective colleges are aware of this agreement including the admissions and advising staffs, transfer coordinators and appropriate faculty and deans.

STUDENT SERVICES

- A. Students will be treated on an equal basis with native students in regards to the award and distribution of financial aid, campus housing, course selection, registration and other student services.
- B. Dickinson College will arrange meetings with Howard Community College students at a mutually agreed upon time to provide information and assistance to students interested in matriculating at Dickinson College.


This agreement has the joint approval of Howard Community College and Dickinson College and is subject to revision upon agreement of the representative institutions. Either institution may end this agreement at any time by written notice of at least one (1) year in advance of the effective date of termination.
